The Nativity Creche being offered as a part of this raffle is a true testament to craftsmanship. Painstakingly hand carved by Palestinians, it brings to life the timeless story of the birth of Jesus. The Nativity Creche being offered was purchased in Bethlehem and travelled over 7,500 miles courtesy of Guild member Leila Giries.

Olive wood carving is an age-old tradition deeply rooted in the rich cultural heritage of Palestine. This ancient craft, introduced by the Franciscans in the 16th and 17th centuries, not only showcases the artistic skills of the Palestinian artists but reflects the enduring spirit of the people who have maintained their connection to the land and their culture despite decades of challenges and conflict.
